

## Laboratory assistantships for female scientists during pregnancy, maternity leave and breastfeeding or children in need of care

Female scientists who are not allowed to carry out their experimental work themselves during pregnancy, maternity leave or breastfeeding or children in need of care may apply for financial means for the employment of a student or research assistant.

The measure is intended to make it easier for female scientists with children to reconcile a scientific career and family. For this purpose, 8,900 euros per year are available until 2024 as a measure to promote equality within the framework of the Female Professors Program III until 2024.

### Requirements:

A condition for the granting of funding is that no or insufficient own funds (e.g. from clinic, institute or department) are available for the hiring or continued employment of an assistant. The applicant must be employed by UMG during the funding period. The maximum funding amount per application is 5,000 euros.

### Application is possible on an open basis.
